



## ***Comprehensive Diabetes Care (CDC)***

**Measure Description:** The percentage of members 18 – 75 years of age with diabetes (Type 1 or Type 2) who had each of the following:

- Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) Testing
- HbA1c poor control (>9.0%)
- HbA1c control (<8.0%)
- HbA1c control (<7.0% for a selected population\*)
- Eye exam (retinal) performed
- Medical attention for nephropathy
- BP control (<140/90 mm Hg)

**Applicable Provider Specialty:** Mixed Specialty

**Attribution Description:** Members are attributed to practices with which they had at least one visit with a diagnosis of diabetes.

**Denominator Definition:** Members age 18 – 75 years of age as of December 31, 2018 who were continuously enrolled in the health plan and had a diagnosis of diabetes as identified by pharmacy data and/or by claims data.

Claims during 2017 and/or 2018

Medical

- Members who had at least two outpatient visits, observation visits, ED visits or non-acute inpatient encounters on different dates of service, with a diagnosis of diabetes. Visit type need not to be the same for the two visits.
- Members who had one visit in an acute inpatient setting with a diagnosis of diabetes

Pharmacy

- At least one claim for insulin or oral hypoglycemics / antihyperglycemics on an outpatient basis

**Qualifying Exclusions:** Members who did not have a diagnosis of diabetes in any setting in 2017 and/or 2018, and who had the following diagnosis:

- Gestational or steroid induced diabetes, in any setting in 2017 or 2018

**Numerator Definitions:** Members who had a claim/encounter for Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) testing in or automated laboratory data during 2018.
